**ESTIMATED REVENUE IMPACT:**

**FY27: Estimated increase of \$52.7 million in wire transmittal fee revenues.**

**ANALYSIS:** The measure would increase the wire transmittal fee for transactions under \$500 from \$5.00 per transaction to \$25.00 and increase the fee for transactions exceeding \$500 from 1% to 5%. Based on FY25 wire transfer fee collections, the measure will result in an estimated increase of \$52.7 million<sup>1</sup> for FY27.

<sup>1</sup> This analysis assumes transaction activity remains consistent and does not account for potential changes in transaction volume or value resulting from the fee changes.
