#### **Bill Summary and Fiscal Analysis:**

SB 2157 creates the Southeast Scenic Rivers Commission for the management of designated scenic river areas or a combination of areas for which operating areas for planning and management have been delineated. The Commission is to be funded by a separate line-item appropriation through the Oklahoma Wildlife Conservation Commission, who shall disburse funds to the Scenic Rivers Commission in the amount prescribed by the Legislature. The proposal lays out the membership makeup and powers and duties of the Commission.

As the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation is not an appropriated agency of the state, there is no immediate fiscal impact. Any fiscal impact would be to establish the Southeast Scenic Rivers Commission, which is subject to the availability of funds prescribed by the Legislature.
