Bill Summary and Fiscal Analysis:

SB 463 creates the Sportsman Hearing Protection Act. The measure provides that a suppressor manufactured and remaining in the state shall not be subject to federal regulation. The measure specifies that basic materials used to manufacture the suppressor shall not qualify the suppressor for federal regulation. The measure prohibits any state entity, political subdivision, or employee from enforcing federal regulations on such items. Citizens may file a complaint with the Attorney General and provide evidence of violations of this Act by the state or entities listed in subsection H. If the Attorney General finds a complaint to be valid, the Attorney General may file a petition for a writ of mandamus or apply for other appropriate equitable relief. The Office of the Attorney General believes these responsibilities can be absorbed by existing staff and does not anticipate a need for additional appropriations.
