16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 27 O.S. 2021, Section 7, is  
18 amended to read as follows:

19 Section 7. A. Except as otherwise provided in this section,  
20 any person, firm or corporation organized under the laws of this  
21 state, or authorized to do business in this state, to furnish light,  
22 heat or power by electricity or natural gas, or any other person,  
23 association or firm engaged in furnishing lights, heat or power by  
24 electricity or natural gas shall have and exercise the right of  
eminent domain in the same manner and by like proceedings as  
provided for railroad corporations by laws of this state.

1 B. The power of eminent domain shall not be used for the siting  
2 or building of wind ~~turbines~~ energy facilities, solar energy  
3 facilities, battery storage facilities, hydrogen gas facilities, or  
4 other renewable energy facilities on private property.

5 C. Prior to seeking to exercise eminent domain for an electric  
6 transmission facility rated greater than three hundred (300)  
7 kilovolts, any person, firm, or corporation under the purview of  
8 subsection A of this section must have obtained a Certificate of  
9 Authority from the Corporation Commission, as required in Enrolled  
10 House Bill No. 2756 of the 1st Session of the 60th Oklahoma  
11 Legislature.

12 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2025.
