12 AMENDMENT NO. 1. Strike the stricken title, enacting clause, and
13 entire bill and insert:
14
15 "An Act relating to the State Capitol Building;
16 creating the State Capitol Arch Memorial Statue
17 Revolving Fund; stating purpose of fund; providing
18 for sources of revenue; providing for the budgeting
19 and expenditure of monies accrued and credited to the
20 fund; prescribing procedures for expenditure; and
21 providing for codification.

23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
24 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 403 of Title 73, unless there is
created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1 There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund
2 for the Office of Management and Enterprise Services (OMES) to be
3 designated the "State Capitol Arch Memorial Statue Revolving Fund".
4 The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year
5 limitations, and shall consist of all monies received by OMES from
6 private donations, gifts, grants, or other sources of private
7 funding provided for the purpose of installing and maintaining
8 veteran memorial statues around the State Capitol Arch. All monies
9 accruing to the credit of the fund are hereby appropriated and may
10 be budgeted and expended by OMES for the purpose provided for in
11 this section. Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon
12 warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as
13 prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of Management and
14 Enterprise Services for approval and payment."

10 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
11 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 403 of Title 73, unless there is
12 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

13 There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund
14 for the Office of Management and Enterprise Services (OMES) to be
15 designated the "State Capitol Arch Memorial Statue Revolving Fund".
16 The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year
17 limitations, and shall consist of all monies received by OMES from
18 private donations, gifts, grants, or other sources of private
19 funding provided for the purpose of installing veteran memorial
20 statues around the State Capitol Arch. All monies accruing to the
21 credit of the fund are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and
22 expended by OMES for the purpose provided for in this section.
23 Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the
24 State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with the

2 approval and payment.
