9 An Act relating to lobbying regulation; prohibiting
10 former members of Legislature from registering as
11 lobbyists for certain period; providing exemption for
12 former members of Legislature registered as lobbyists
13 before certain date; providing for codification; and
14 providing an effective date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Rule 5.30, Appendix I of Title 74,
18 unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as
19 follows:

20 Beginning on November 1, 2026, no former member of the Oklahoma
21 House of Representatives or the Oklahoma State Senate may work or
22 register as a lobbyist until four (4) years after their last term
23 has expired. This act shall not apply to former members of the
24 Legislature who have become registered lobbyists prior to November
1, 2026.
