9 An Act relating to air emission standards; defining  
10 term; prohibiting the burning of medical waste by  
11 certain facilities; providing for codification; and  
12 providing an effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2-5-131 of Title 27A, unless  
17 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 A. As used in this section, the term "hospital, medical, or  
19 infectious waste" means hospital waste or medical/infectious waste  
20 as those terms are defined in 40 C.F.R., Section 60.51c, as in  
21 effect on the effective date of this act.

22 B. Any facility that does not meet the current standards,  
23 emission limitations, operating requirements, and monitoring,  
24 reporting, and permitting requirements applicable to medical waste

1 incinerators promulgated by the United States Environmental  
2 Protection Agency shall be prohibited from burning hospital or  
3 medical/infectious waste in this state.

4 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2026.
