- 2. Any individual convicted of a second offense shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by a fine not more than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), by imprisonment in a county jail for not more than one hundred eighty (180) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.
- 3. Any individual convicted of a third or subsequent offense shall, upon conviction, be punished by a fine not more than One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00), by imprisonment in a county jail for not more than one (1) year, or by both such fine and imprisonment.
- 4. Any individual convicted pursuant to the provisions of this subsection shall also be liable for damages.
- C. The Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry shall promulgate rules necessary to implement the provisions of this act.
- SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2025.
