16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
17	SECTION 1. A. From the funds appropriated to the Office of
18	Educational Quality and Accountability in Enrolled House Bill No.
19	2766 of the 1st Session of the 60th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of
20	Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00) shall be used to provide
21	grants to school districts in this state to provide a cellphone-free
22	educational environment.
23	B. Grants awarded pursuant to this section shall be used to
24	purchase devices or equipment in which students enrolled in a grant

recipient school site can store their cell phones during the school day. In conjunction with the Office of Management and Enterprise Services, the Office of Educational Quality and Accountability may negotiate and enter into a contract with a vendor to offer a state rate price to grant recipient school sites; provided, however, a grant recipient school site shall not be required to use a vendor contracted by the Office of Educational Quality and Accountability.

- C. The Office of Educational Quality and Accountability shall be authorized to promulgate rules in order to effectuate the provisions of this section.
- 11 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2025.
  - SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
