There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Water 3 SECTION 2. Resources Board from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the 4 5 Progressing Rural Economic Prosperity Fund of the State Treasury created in Section 256 of Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the sum 6 of Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) for the purpose of 7 constructing water lines in a county with a population greater than 8 9 one hundred fifty thousand (150,000) and less than two hundred thousand (200,000) according to the latest Federal Decennial Census 10 and located in a community not adjacent to a major roadway 11 12 designated as an interstate.

SECTION 3. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Water 13 Resources Board from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the 14 Progressing Rural Economic Prosperity Fund of the State Treasury 15 created in Section 256 of Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the sum 16 17 of Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00) for the purpose of establishing grant programs that facilitate the design, 18 construction, and maintenance of water and wastewater 19 infrastructure, and to improve the condition of publicly owned, 20 deficient dams regulated by the Oklahoma Water Resources Board. 21 SECTION 4. This act shall become effective July 1, 2025. 22 SECTION 5. It being immediately necessary for the preservation 23 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby 24
