18	sum of One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) shall be used for the

20	Products Center for operational expenses.
21	SECTION 2. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma

    No. 2766 of the 1st Session of the 60th Oklahoma Legislature, the

    shall be used for cooperative extension and agriculture research
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    programs that are affiliated with Langston University.
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        SECTION 5. This act shall become effective July 1, 2025.

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    declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
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    be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
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
