10 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Department of
11 Commerce; requiring that portions of certain
12 appropriated funds be used for certain purposes;
providing an effective date; and declaring an
emergency.

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14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma
16 Department of Commerce in Enrolled House Bill No. 2766 of the 1st
17 Session of the 60th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of Five Hundred
18 Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00) shall be used to support the
19 Community Expansion of Nutrition Assistance Program.

20 SECTION 2. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma
21 Department of Commerce in Enrolled House Bill No. 2766 of the 1st
22 Session of the 60th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of One Hundred
23 Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) shall be used to provide support to
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1 an Oklahoma-based nonprofit in order to preserve sports heritage and
2 pride in Oklahoma.

3 SECTION 3. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma
4 Department of Commerce in Enrolled House Bill No. 2766 of the 1st
5 Session of the 60th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of One Hundred
6 Ninety-eight Thousand Six Hundred Sixty Dollars (\$198,660.00) shall
7 be used for community action agencies to support Head Start
8 programs, and shall not be used for administrative expenses.

9 SECTION 4. This act shall become effective July 1, 2025.

10 SECTION 5. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
11 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
12 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
13 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
