6 An Act relating to state government; creating the  
7 Statewide Official Compensation Commission; providing  
8 for membership of commission; authorizing meetings  
9 based on meetings of the Board on Legislative  
10 Compensation; requiring Statewide Official  
11 Compensation Commission to set salaries for certain  
12 public officials; prohibiting modification of salary  
13 amounts in contravention of Section 10 of Article  
14 XXIII of the Oklahoma Constitution; amending 74 O.S.  
15 2021, Section 250.4, which relates to state officer  
16 salaries; providing for operative effect of salary  
17 provisions; providing for effect of action taken by  
18 Statewide Official Compensation Commission; repealing  
19 74 O.S. 2021, Section 250.4, which relates to public  
20 official compensation; providing for codification;  
21 and providing effective dates.

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23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

24 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 291.4 of Title 74, unless there  
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. There is hereby created the Statewide Official Compensation  
Commission.

B. The Statewide Official Compensation Commission shall consist  
of the same persons who constitute the Board on Legislative

1 Compensation as provided by Section 21 of Article V of the Oklahoma  
2 Constitution.

3 C. The Statewide Official Compensation Commission shall be  
4 authorized to meet only on the same date as the Board on Legislative  
5 Compensation.

6 D. The Statewide Official Compensation Commission shall set the  
7 salary for each of the following elected officials:

- 8 1. The Governor;
- 9 2. The Lieutenant Governor;
- 10 3. The Attorney General;
- 11 4. The State Treasurer;
- 12 5. The State Auditor and Inspector;
- 13 6. The Superintendent of Public Instruction;
- 14 7. The State Insurance Commissioner;
- 15 8. The Commissioner of Labor; and
- 16 9. The members of the Oklahoma Corporation Commission.

17 E. The Statewide Official Compensation Commission shall not set  
18 the salary for any of the officials identified in subsection D of  
19 this section at an amount less than the salary in effect for such  
20 officials as of January 1, 2025.

21 F. At its authorized meeting, the Statewide Official  
22 Compensation Commission shall set the salary for each of the  
23 officials identified in subsection D of this section for any term of  
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1 office for such officials beginning on or after the date as of which  
2 the Commission sets the salary amount.

3 G. The Statewide Official Compensation Commission shall not  
4 modify a salary amount in violation of the requirements of Section  
5 10 of Article XXIII of the Oklahoma Constitution.

6 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2021, Section 250.4, is  
7 amended to read as follows:

8 Section 250.4. A. Pursuant to provisions of the Constitution  
9 of the State of Oklahoma from and after the beginning date of a term  
10 of office which commences in, or after, January 2016, and except as  
11 otherwise provided by this section, the following officers of the  
12 State of Oklahoma shall be annually compensated for their services,  
13 payable monthly, as follows:

14 1. The Governor shall receive a salary of One Hundred Forty-  
15 seven Thousand Dollars (\$147,000.00);

16 2. The Lieutenant Governor shall receive a salary of One  
17 Hundred Fourteen Thousand Seven Hundred Thirteen Dollars  
18 (\$114,713.00);

19 3. The Attorney General shall receive a salary of One Hundred  
20 Thirty-two Thousand Eight Hundred Twenty-five Dollars (\$132,825.00);

21 4. The State Superintendent of Public Instruction shall receive  
22 a salary of One Hundred Twenty-four Thousand Three Hundred Seventy-  
23 three Dollars (\$124,373.00);

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1       5. Each member of the Corporation Commission shall receive a  
2 salary of One Hundred Fourteen Thousand Seven Hundred Thirteen  
3 Dollars (\$114,713.00);

4       6. The State Treasurer shall receive a salary of One Hundred  
5 Fourteen Thousand Seven Hundred Thirteen Dollars (\$114,713.00);

6       7. The State Auditor and Inspector shall receive a salary of  
7 One Hundred Fourteen Thousand Seven Hundred Thirteen Dollars  
8 (\$114,713.00);

9       8. The State Insurance Commissioner shall receive a salary of  
10 One Hundred Fourteen Thousand Seven Hundred Thirteen Dollars  
11 (\$114,713.00); and

12       9. The Commissioner of Labor shall receive a salary of One  
13 Hundred Five Thousand Fifty-three Dollars (\$105,053.00).

14       B. With respect to any public official whose salary is provided  
15 for by this section, the provisions of this section shall be  
16 operative until the Statewide Official Compensation Commission  
17 modifies the salary amount for such official. If the Statewide  
18 Official Compensation Commission modifies the salary amount as  
19 otherwise prescribed by this section, the order of the Commission  
20 shall supersede the provisions of this section with respect to the  
21 applicable statewide elected official.

22       SECTION 3.       REPEALER       74 O.S. 2021, Section 250.4, as  
23 amended by Section 2 of this act, is hereby repealed.

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SECTION 4. Sections 1 and 2 of this act shall become effective  
November 1, 2025.

SECTION 5. Section 3 of this act shall become effective January  
31, 2030.
