"Biotechnology company of concern" means an entity 16 1. designated by the federal government to be under the control of a 17 foreign adversary and that poses a risk to national security based 18 on the company's research of multiomic data collection; and 19 20 2. "Multiomics" means a biological analysis method that combines data from multiple research areas, including, but not 21 limited to, genomics, transcriptomics, proteomics, epigenomics, and 22 metabolomics in order to gain a comprehensive understanding of 23 complex biological processes. 24

B. Any state agency that receives federal or state funds shall
not be authorized to use or procure any biotechnology equipment or
service that originates from a company designated by the federal
government to be a biotechnology company of concern nor shall any
such state agency contract with an entity that uses or procures such
biotechnology.

7 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon the enactment of a 8 federal law that prohibits entities that receive federal funds from 9 using biotechnology that is from a company associated with a foreign 10 adversary.
