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10 AS INTRODUCED

11 A Joint Resolution directing the Secretary of State
12 to refer to the people for their approval or
13 rejection a proposed amendment to Section 2 of
14 Article XXV-A of the Constitution of the State of
15 Oklahoma; allowing the State of Oklahoma not cover
16 Medicaid expansion if federal financial participation
17 drops below ninety-percent matching; providing ballot
18 title; and directing filing.

19 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE SENATE OF THE
20 2ND SESSION OF THE 60TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

21 SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for
22 their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law,
23 the following proposed amendment to Section 2 of Article XXV-A of
24 the Constitution of the State of Oklahoma to read as follows:

1 A. In addition to those otherwise eligible for medical
2 assistance under Oklahoma's Medicaid program, the State shall
3 provide medical assistance under Oklahoma's Medicaid program to Low
4 Income Adults.

5 B. No greater or additional burdens or restrictions on
6 eligibility or enrollment shall be imposed on persons eligible for
7 medical assistance pursuant to this Article than on any other
8 population eligible for medical assistance under Oklahoma's Medicaid
9 program.

10 C. If the federal financial participation is less than ninety
11 percent (90%) for Medicaid expansion, the Oklahoma Legislature may
12 decide to not cover the additional costs to the state.

13 SECTION 2. The Ballot Title for the proposed Constitutional
14 amendment as set forth in SECTION 1 of this resolution shall be in
15 the following form:

18 THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS:

19 This measure amends the Oklahoma Constitution. The measure
20 amends Section 2 of Article 25A by allowing the State of
21 Oklahoma to not cover the Medicaid expansion if the federal
22 financial participation drops below ninety percent (90%)
23 matching.
