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19	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
20	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 26 O.S. 2021, Section 13A-103, is
21	amended to read as follows:
22	Section 13A-103. A. 1. The general election of members of the
23	board of education of every school district and technology center
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school district shall be conducted on the first Tuesday of April of
 each year after the first Monday of November any year.

2. The primary election of members of the board of education of
every school district and technology center school district, if
necessary, shall be conducted on the second Tuesday in February of
each year, except in any year when a Presidential Preferential
Primary is held in February, then the election shall be held on the
same day as the Presidential Preferential Primary the fourth Tuesday
of August in any month.

If only two candidates qualify to have their names appear on
 the ballot, the names of both candidates shall appear on the ballot
 at the board of education general election.

4. If more than two candidates qualify to have their names 13 appear on the ballot, the names of all such candidates shall appear 14 on the ballot at the board of education primary election. 15 А candidate receiving more than fifty percent (50%) of the votes cast 16 in the board of education primary election shall be elected to the 17 office. If no candidate receives more than fifty percent (50%) of 18 the votes cast in the board of education primary election, then the 19 two candidates with the highest number of votes shall appear on the 20 ballot at the board of education general election. 21

B. Elections on the question of making a levy or levies for schools under Section 9, Section 9B or Section 10 of Article X of the Oklahoma Constitution shall be held on the second Tuesday in February of each year, except in any year when a Presidential
 Preferential Primary is held in February, then the election shall be
 held on the same day as the Presidential Preferential Primary.

C. The board of education of every school district or
technology center school district may call a special election for
the purpose of voting on any matter or question authorized by law.
SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 26 O.S. 2021, Section 13A-105, is
amended to read as follows:

9 Section 13A-105. Candidates for member of the board of 10 education of every school district or technology center school district shall file declarations of candidacy in the same place and 11 with the same officials as candidates for county office. 12 The declaration of candidacy to be signed by the candidate shall have an 13 attachment to be signed by the candidate listing the requirements of 14 a candidate for election or reelection to a school board as set 15 forth in Sections 13A-106 and 5-105a of this title and Sections 5-16 110, 5-110.1, and 5-113 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes, and 17 the candidate shall swear or affirm that he or she is eligible to 18 run for the office or serve in the office if elected. Candidates 19 20 shall file no earlier than 8:00 a.m. on the first Monday Wednesday in December April through no later than 5:00 p.m. on the following 21 Wednesday next succeeding Friday. For school districts and 22 technology center school districts located in more than one county, 23

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1	filing may be either in the county wherein supervision of the
2	district is located or in the county where the candidate resides.
3	SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2026.
