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10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

11 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
12 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1604 of Title 22, unless there
13 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

14 A. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving
15 fund for the Office of the Attorney General to be designated the
16 "Domestic Violence Fatality Review Board Revolving Fund". The fund
17 shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations,
18 and shall consist of all monies received from legislative
19 appropriations. All monies accruing to the credit of the fund are
20 hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the Office
21 of the Attorney General for the purposes provided in subsection B of
22 this section. Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon
23 warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as
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1 prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of Management and
2 Enterprise Services for approval and payment.

3 B. The purpose of the fund is to develop a state and local
4 database on domestic violence deaths pursuant to paragraph 3 of
5 subsection A of Section 1601 of Title 22 of the Oklahoma Statutes.
6 Such database shall be developed and implemented within twenty-four
7 (24) months of the effective date of this act.

8 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2026.

9 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
10 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
11 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
12 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
