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8 An Act relating to public health; **requiring primary**
9 **health care providers to offer** pediatric screenings
10 for type 1 diabetes **subject to certain conditions;**
11 providing for certain reimbursement; directing the
State Department of Health to seek certain funding;
directing promulgation of rules; providing for
codification; and providing an effective date.

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14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-581 of Title 63, unless there
17 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 A. Every primary health care provider **in this state shall offer**
19 **pediatric screenings** for type 1 diabetes in accordance with accepted
20 medical practices and rules promulgated by the State Commissioner of
21 Health **and subject to the informed consent of the child's parent or**
22 **legal guardian.**

1 B. The screenings described in subsection A of this section
2 shall be reimbursable under the state Medicaid program, subject to
3 receipt of any necessary federal approval.

4 C. The State Department of Health shall seek grants and other
5 funding opportunities to support the provision of pediatric
6 screenings for type 1 diabetes as described in subsection A of this
7 section.

8 D. 1. The State Commissioner of Health shall promulgate rules
9 necessary to implement the provisions of this section.

10 2. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority Board shall promulgate
11 rules necessary to implement subsection B of this section.

12 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2026.
