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12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:			
13	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2021, Section 6-101, as			
14	last amended by Section 34, Chapter 452, O.S.L. 2024 (47 O.S. Supp.			
15	2024, Section 6-101), is amended to read as follows:			
16	Section 6-101. A. No person, except those hereinafter			
17	expressly exempted in Sections 6-102 and 6-102.1 of this title,			
18	shall operate any motor vehicle upon a highway in this state unless			
19	the person has a valid Oklahoma driver license for the class of			
20	vehicle being operated under the provisions of this title. No			
21	person shall be permitted to possess more than one valid license at			
22	any time, except as provided in paragraph 4 of subsection F of this			
23	section.			

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B. 1. No person shall operate a Class A commercial motor
vehicle unless the person is eighteen (18) years of age or older and
holds a valid Class A commercial license, except as provided in
paragraph 5 of this subsection and subsection F of this section.
Any person holding a valid Class A commercial license shall be
permitted to operate motor vehicles in Classes A, B, C, and D,
except as provided for in paragraph 4 of this subsection.

8 2. No person shall operate a Class B commercial motor vehicle 9 unless the person is eighteen (18) years of age or older and holds a 10 valid Class B commercial license, except as provided in paragraph 5 11 of subsection F of this section. Any person holding a valid Class B 12 commercial license shall be permitted to operate motor vehicles in 13 Classes B, C, and D, except as provided for in paragraph 4 of this 14 subsection.

3. No person shall operate a Class C commercial motor vehicle 15 unless the person is eighteen (18) years of age or older and holds a 16 valid Class C commercial license, except as provided in subsection F 17 of this section. Any person holding a valid Class C commercial 18 license shall be permitted to operate motor vehicles in Classes C 19 and D, except as provided for in paragraph 4 of this subsection. 20 4. No person under twenty-one (21) years of age shall be 21 licensed to operate any motor vehicle which is required to be 22

23 placarded for hazardous materials pursuant to 49 C.F.R., Part 172, 24 subpart F, except as provided in subsection F of this section;

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provided, a person eighteen (18) years of age or older may be licensed to operate a farm vehicle which is required to be placarded for hazardous materials pursuant to 49 C.F.R., Part 172, subpart F, except as provided in subsection F of this section.

5 5. A person at least seventeen (17) years of age who
6 successfully completes all examinations required by law may be
7 issued by Service Oklahoma:

- a. a restricted Class A commercial license which shall
   grant to the licensee the privilege to operate a Class
   A or Class B commercial motor vehicle for harvest
   purposes or a Class D motor vehicle, or
- b. a restricted Class B commercial license which shall
   grant to the licensee the privilege to operate a Class
   B commercial motor vehicle for harvest purposes or a
   Class D motor vehicle.

16 6. No person shall operate a Class D motor vehicle unless the
17 person is sixteen (16) years of age or older and holds a valid Class
18 D license, except as provided for in Section 6-102 or 6-105 of this
19 title. Any person holding a valid Class D license shall be
20 permitted to operate motor vehicles in Class D only.

C. Any person issued a driver license pursuant to this section may exercise the privilege thereby granted upon all streets and highways in this state.

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1 D. No person shall operate a motorcycle or motor-driven cycle without having a valid Class A, B, C, or D license with a motorcycle 2 endorsement. Except as otherwise provided by law, any new applicant 3 for an original driver license shall be required to successfully 4 5 complete a written examination, vision examination, and driving examination for a motorcycle as prescribed by the Department of 6 Public Safety, in conjunction with Service Oklahoma, and a certified 7 state-approved motorcycle basic rider course approved by the 8 9 Department, in conjunction with Service Oklahoma, if the applicant 10 is seventeen (17) years of age or younger to be eligible for a motorcycle endorsement thereon. The written examination and driving 11 12 examination for a motorcycle shall be waived by Service Oklahoma upon verification that the person has successfully completed a 13 certified Motorcycle Safety Foundation rider course approved by the 14 Department, in conjunction with Service Oklahoma. 15

Except as otherwise provided by law, any person who lawfully 16 Ε. possesses a valid Oklahoma driver license which is eligible for 17 renewal shall be required to successfully complete a written 18 examination, vision examination, and driving examination for a 19 motorcycle as prescribed by the Department, in conjunction with 20 Service Oklahoma, and a certified state-approved motorcycle basic 21 rider course approved by the Department, in conjunction with Service 22 Oklahoma, if the person is seventeen (17) years of age or younger to 23 be eligible for a motorcycle endorsement. The written examination 24

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1 and driving examination for a motorcycle shall be waived by Service 2 Oklahoma upon verification that the person has successfully completed a certified Motorcycle Safety Foundation rider course 3 approved by the Department, in conjunction with Service Oklahoma. 4 5 F. 1. Any person eighteen (18) years of age or older may apply for a restricted Class A, B, or C commercial learner permit. 6 Service Oklahoma, after the applicant has passed all parts of the 7 examination for a Class D license and has successfully passed all 8 9 parts of the examination for a Class A, B, or C commercial license 10 other than the driving examination, may issue to the applicant a commercial learner permit which shall entitle the person having 11 12 immediate lawful possession of the commercial learner permit and a valid Oklahoma driver license or provisional driver license pursuant 13 to Section 6-212 of this title to operate a Class A, B, or C 14 commercial motor vehicle upon the public highways solely for the 15 purpose of behind-the-wheel training in accordance with rules 16 promulgated by the Department. 17

2. This commercial learner permit shall be issued for a period as provided in Section 6-115 of this title of one year; provided, such commercial learner permit may be suspended, revoked, canceled, denied, or disqualified at the discretion of the Department, with notice to Service Oklahoma, for violation of the restrictions, for failing to give the required or correct information on the application, or for violation of any traffic laws of this state

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pertaining to the operation of a motor vehicle. Except as otherwise 1 provided, the lawful possessor of a commercial learner permit who 2 has been issued a commercial learner permit for a minimum of 3 fourteen (14) days may have the restriction requiring an 4 5 accompanying driver removed by satisfactorily completing a driver's examination; provided, the removal of a restriction shall not 6 authorize the operation of a Class A, B, or C commercial motor 7 vehicle if such operation is otherwise prohibited by law. 8

9 3. No person shall apply for and Service Oklahoma shall not issue an original Class A, B, or C driver license until the person 10 has been issued a commercial learner permit and held the permit for 11 12 at least fourteen (14) days. Any person who currently holds a Class B or C license and who wishes to apply for another class of 13 commercial driver license shall be required to apply for a 14 commercial learner permit and to hold the permit for at least 15 fourteen (14) days before applying for the Class A or B license, as 16 applicable. Any person who currently holds a Class A, B, or C 17 license and who wishes to add an endorsement or remove a restriction 18 for which a skills examination is required shall be required to 19 apply for a commercial learner permit and to hold the permit for at 20 least fourteen (14) days before applying for the endorsement. 21

4. A commercial learner permit shall be issued by Service
Oklahoma as a separate and unique document which shall be valid only
in conjunction with a valid Oklahoma driver license or provisional

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5 5. After one renewal of a commercial learner permit, as provided in paragraph 2 of this subsection, a commercial permit 6 shall not be renewed again. Any person who has held a commercial 7 learner permit for the initial issuance period and one renewal 8 9 period shall not be eligible for and Service Oklahoma shall not 10 issue another renewal of the permit; provided, the person may 11 reapply for a new commercial learner permit, as provided for in this 12 subsection.

G. 1. For purposes of this title: 13 "REAL ID Compliant Driver License" License or a. 14 "Identification Identification Card" means a driver 15 license or identification card issued by this state 16 that has been certified by the United States 17 Department of Homeland Security (USDHS) as compliant 18 with the requirements of the REAL ID Act of 2005, 19 Public Law No. 109-13. A REAL ID Compliant Driver 20 License or Identification Card and the process through 21 which it is issued incorporate a variety of security 22 measures designed to protect the integrity and 23 trustworthiness of the license or card. A REAL ID 24

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Compliant Driver License or Identification Card will be clearly marked on the face indicating that it is a compliant document, and

b. "REAL ID Noncompliant Driver License" License or 4 5 "Identification Identification Card" means a driver license or identification card issued by this state 6 that has not been certified by the United States 7 Department of Homeland Security (USDHS) as being 8 9 compliant with the requirements of the REAL ID Act of 2005. A REAL ID Noncompliant Driver License or 10 Identification Card will be clearly marked on the face 11 indicating that it is not compliant with the federal 12 13 REAL ID Act of 2005 and is not acceptable for official federal purposes. The driver license or 14 identification card will have a unique design or color 15 indicator that clearly distinguishes it from a 16 compliant license or card. 17

Original Driver License and Identification Card Issuance: 2. 18 Application for an original REAL ID Compliant or REAL 19 a. ID Noncompliant Driver License or Identification Card 20 shall be made to Service Oklahoma or a licensed 21 operator provided such licensed operator is authorized 22 to process application for REAL ID Compliant Driver 23 Licenses and Identification Cards. Application for a 24

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REAL ID Noncompliant Driver License or Identification Card shall be made to Service Oklahoma.

- Service Oklahoma employees or authorized licensed 3 b. operators shall perform all document recognition and 4 5 other requirements needed for approval of an original REAL ID Compliant Driver License or Identification 6 Card application. Service Oklahoma employees shall 7 perform all document recognition and other 8 9 requirements needed for approval of a REAL ID Noncompliant Driver License or Identification Card 10 application. 11
- 12 c. Upon approval of an original REAL ID Compliant or REAL 13 ID Noncompliant Driver License or Identification Card 14 application, the applicant may take the approved 15 application document to a licensed operator to receive 16 a temporary driver license or identification card.
- d. The licensed operator shall process the approved REAL 17 ID Compliant or REAL ID Noncompliant Driver License or 18 Identification Card application and upon payment shall 19 provide the applicant a temporary driver license or 20 identification card. A temporary driver license or 21 identification card shall afford the holder the 22 privileges otherwise granted by the specific class of 23 driver license or identification card for the period 24

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of time listed on the temporary driver license or identification card or the period of time prior to the applicant receiving a REAL ID Compliant or REAL ID Noncompliant Driver License or Identification Card, whichever time period is shorter.

6 3. REAL ID Compliant Driver License and Identification Card7 Renewal and Replacement:

- Application for renewal or replacement of a REAL ID 8 a. 9 Compliant Driver License or Identification Card may be made to Service Oklahoma or to a licensed operator; 10 provided, such licensed operator is authorized to 11 12 process application for REAL ID Compliant Driver Licenses and Identification Cards. A licensed 13 operator may process the voluntary downgrade of a REAL 14 ID Compliant Commercial Driver License to any lower 15 class license upon request of the licensee;, provided, 16 no additional endorsements or restrictions are placed 17 on the license. 18
- b. Service Oklahoma employees or authorized licensed
  operators shall perform all document recognition and
  other requirements needed for approval of a renewal or
  replacement REAL ID Compliant Driver License or
  Identification Card application.
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- c. Upon approval of a renewal or replacement REAL ID
   Compliant Driver License or Identification Card
   application, the applicant may receive a temporary
   driver license or identification card from Service
   Oklahoma or an authorized licensed operator.
- A temporary driver license or identification card 6 d. acquired under the provisions of this paragraph shall 7 afford the holder the privileges otherwise granted by 8 9 the specific class of driver license or identification card being renewed or replaced for the period of time 10 listed on the temporary driver license or 11 identification card or the period of time prior to the 12 13 applicant receiving a REAL ID Compliant Driver License or Identification Card, whichever time period is 14 shorter. 15
- e. For purposes of this title, an application for a REAL
  ID Compliant Driver License or Identification Card by
  an individual with a valid Oklahoma-issued driver
  license or identification card shall be considered a
  renewal of a REAL ID Compliant Driver License or
  Identification Card.
- 4. REAL ID Noncompliant Driver License and Identification CardRenewal and Replacement:
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1 Application for renewal or replacement of a REAL ID a. Noncompliant Driver License or Identification Card may 2 be made to Service Oklahoma or to a licensed operator. 3 A licensed operator may process the voluntary 4 5 downgrade of a REAL ID Noncompliant Commercial Driver License to any lower class license upon request of the 6 licensee;, provided, no additional endorsements or 7 restrictions are added to the license. 8

- 9 b. Service Oklahoma employees or licensed operators shall
  10 perform all document recognition and other
  11 requirements needed for approval of a renewal or
  12 replacement REAL ID Noncompliant Driver License or
  13 Identification Card application.
- 14 c. Upon approval of a renewal or replacement REAL ID
  15 Noncompliant Driver License or Identification Card
  16 application, the applicant may receive a temporary
  17 driver license or identification card from Service
  18 Oklahoma or a licensed operator.
- 19 d. A temporary driver license or identification card
  20 acquired under the provisions of this paragraph shall
  21 afford the holder the privileges otherwise granted by
  22 the specific class of driver license or identification
  23 card being renewed or replaced for the period of time
  24 listed on the temporary driver license or

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M. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 1104 of this
 title, of each fee charged pursuant to the provisions of subsections
 J, K, and L of this section:

Five Dollars and fifty cents (\$5.50) of a 4-year four-year 4 5 license or Eleven Dollars (\$11.00) of an 8-year eight-year license shall be deposited to the Trauma Care Assistance Revolving Fund 6 created in Section 1-2530.9 of Title 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes; 7 2. Six Dollars and seventy-five cents (\$6.75) of a 4-year four-8 9 year license or Thirteen Dollars and fifty cents (\$13.50) of an 8-10 year eight-year license shall be deposited to the Department of Public Safety Computer Imaging System Revolving Fund to be used 11 solely for the purpose of administration and maintenance of the 12 computerized imaging system of the Department through October 31, 13 2022. Beginning November 1, 2022, Six Dollars and seventy-five 14 cents (\$6.75) of a 4-year four-year license or Thirteen Dollars and 15 fifty cents (\$13.50) of an 8-year eight-year license shall be 16 deposited to the Service Oklahoma Computer Imaging System Revolving 17 Fund to be used solely for the purpose of administration and 18 maintenance of the computerized imaging system of Service Oklahoma; 19 3. Ten Dollars (\$10.00) of a 4-year four-year license or Twenty 20 Dollars (\$20.00) of an 8-year eight-year license shall be deposited 21 to the Department of Public Safety Revolving Fund for all original 22 or renewal issuances of licenses through October 31, 2022. 23 Beginning November 1, 2022, Ten Dollars (\$10.00) of a 4-year four-24

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year license or Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) of an 8-year eight-year
 license shall be deposited to the Service Oklahoma Revolving Fund
 for all original or renewal issuances of licenses; and

4 4. Five Dollars (\$5.00) of a 4-year four-year license or Six
5 Dollars (\$6.00) of an 8-year eight-year license shall be deposited
6 to the State Public Safety Fund created in Section 2-147 of this
7 title.

8 N. All original and renewal driver licenses shall expire as9 provided in Section 6-115 of this title.

10 0. 1. Through May 31, 2025, any person sixty-two (62) to 11 sixty-four (64) years of age during the calendar year of issuance or 12 renewal of a Class D license or motorcycle endorsement shall be 13 charged the following prorated fee:

Any person sixty-five (65) years of age or older during the

P. No person who has been honorably discharged from active
service in any branch of the Armed Forces of the United States or
Oklahoma National Guard and who has been certified by the United
States Department of Veterans Affairs, its successor, or the Armed

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1 Forces of the United States to be a disabled veteran in receipt of 2 compensation at the one-hundred-percent rate for a permanent disability sustained through military action or accident resulting 3 from disease contracted while in such active service and registered 4 5 with the veterans registry created by the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs shall be charged a fee for the issuance, 6 replacement, or renewal of an Oklahoma driver license; provided, 7 that if a veteran has been previously exempt from a fee pursuant to 8 9 this subsection, no registration with the veterans registry shall be 10 required.

Q. In accordance with the provisions of subsection G of this 11 12 section, Service Oklahoma is authorized to promulgate rules for the issuance and renewal of driver licenses authorized pursuant to the 13 provisions of Sections 6-101 through 6-309 of this title; provided, 14 that no such rules applicable to the issuance or renewal of REAL ID 15 Noncompliant Driver Licenses shall create more stringent standards 16 than such rules applicable as of January 1, 2017, unless directly 17 related to a specific change in statutory law concerning standards 18 for REAL ID Noncompliant Driver Licenses. Applications, upon forms 19 approved by Service Oklahoma, for such licenses shall be handled, in 20 accordance with the provisions of subsection G of this section, by 21 the licensed operator; provided, Service Oklahoma is authorized to 22 assume these duties in any county of this state. Each licensed 23 operator accepting applications for driver licenses shall receive 24

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1 Six Dollars (\$6.00) for a 4-year four-year REAL ID Noncompliant Driver License or Twelve Dollars (\$12.00) for an 8-year eight-year 2 REAL ID Noncompliant Driver License or Ten Dollars (\$10.00) for a 4-3 year four-year REAL ID Compliant Driver License or Twenty Dollars 4 5 (\$20.00) for an 8-year eight-year REAL ID Compliant Driver License to be deducted from the total collected for each license or renewal 6 application accepted through June 30, 2023. Beginning July 1, 2022, 7 and ending on June 30, 2023, each motor license agent or licensed 8 9 operator accepting applications for driver licenses for individuals 10 over the age of sixty-five (65) years or for applications for drivers pursuant to subsection P of this section shall receive Six 11 12 Dollars (\$6.00) for a 4-year four-year driver license or Twelve Dollars (\$12.00) for an <del>8-year</del> eight-year driver license to be 13 deducted daily by the motor license agent or licensed operator 14 receipts. Beginning July 1, 2023, these fees shall be retained by 15 the licensed operator pursuant to subsection E of Section 1141.1 of 16 this title. The fees received by the licensed operator, authorized 17 by this subsection, shall be used for operating expenses. 18 The amount retained pursuant to this subsection shall not be retained by 19 any state agency. The fees received by the licensed operator, 20 authorized by this subsection, shall be used for operating expenses. 21 For purposes of this subsection, "licensed operator" shall mean an 22 individual who obtains a license from the Service Oklahoma Operator 23 Board to operate a designated Service Oklahoma location and offers 24

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third-party fulfillment of designated services to be rendered by
 Service Oklahoma.

R. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 1104 of this title
and subsection Q of this section and except as provided in
subsections H and M of this section, the first Sixty Thousand
Dollars (\$60,000.00) of all monies collected pursuant to this
section shall be paid by the Oklahoma Tax Commission to the State
Treasurer to be deposited in the General Revenue Fund of the State
Treasury.

The next Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00) of monies 10 collected pursuant to this section shall be paid by the Tax 11 12 Commission to the State Treasurer to be deposited each fiscal year under the provisions of this section to the credit of the Department 13 of Public Safety Restricted Revolving Fund for the purpose of the 14 Oklahoma Law Enforcement Telecommunications System. All other 15 monies collected in excess of Five Hundred Sixty Thousand Dollars 16 (\$560,000.00) each fiscal year shall be apportioned as provided in 17 Section 1104 of this title, except as otherwise provided in this 18 section. 19

S. Service Oklahoma shall retain the images displayed on licenses and identification cards issued pursuant to the provisions of Sections 6-101 through 6-309 of this title which may be used only:

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By a law enforcement agency for purposes of criminal
 investigations, missing person investigations, or any law
 enforcement purpose which is deemed necessary by the Commissioner of
 Public Safety;

5 2. By the driver licensing agency of another state for its6 official purpose; and

3. As provided in Section 2-110 of this title.

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All agencies approved by the Oklahoma Law Enforcement Telecommunications System (OLETS) or the National Law Enforcement Telecommunications System (NLETS) to receive photographs or computerized images may obtain them through OLETS or through NLETS. Photographs or computerized images may be obtained by law enforcement one inquiry at a time.

14 The computer system and related equipment acquired for this 15 purpose must conform to industry standards for interoperability and 16 open architecture. The Department of Public Safety may promulgate 17 rules to implement the provisions of this subsection.

T. No person may hold more than one state-issued or territoryissued REAL ID Compliant Driver License or REAL ID Compliant
Identification Card from Oklahoma or any other state or territory.
Service Oklahoma shall not issue a REAL ID Compliant Driver License
to a person who has been previously issued a REAL ID Compliant
Driver License or REAL ID Compliant Identification Card until such
license or identification card has been surrendered to Service

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Oklahoma by the applicant. Service Oklahoma may promulgate rules
 related to the issuance of replacement REAL ID Compliant Driver
 Licenses in the event of loss or theft.

U.
