6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to driver licenses; amending 47 O.S.
8 2021, Section 6-101, as last amended by Section 3,
9 Chapter 330, O.S.L. 2025 (47 O.S. Supp. 2025, Section
10 6-101), which relates to the class requirements for
11 driver licenses; requiring that certain persons not
12 be charged certain fee; updating statutory language;
13 updating statutory reference; and providing an
14 effective date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2021, Section 6-101, as
17 last amended by Section 3, Chapter 330, O.S.L. 2025 (47 O.S. Supp.
18 2025, Section 6-101), is amended to read as follows:

19 Section 6-101. A. No person, except those hereinafter
20 expressly exempted in Sections 6-102 and 6-102.1 of this title,
21 shall operate any motor vehicle upon a highway in this state unless
22 the person has a valid Oklahoma driver license for the class of
23 vehicle being operated under the provisions of this title. No
24 person shall be permitted to possess more than one valid license at
any time, except as provided in paragraph 4 of subsection F of this
section.

1 B. 1. No person shall operate a Class A commercial motor
2 vehicle unless the person is eighteen (18) years of age or older and
3 holds a valid Class A commercial license, except as provided in
4 paragraph 5 of this subsection and subsection F of this section.
5 Any person holding a valid Class A commercial license shall be
6 permitted to operate motor vehicles in Classes A, B, C and D, except
7 as provided for in paragraph 4 of this subsection.

8 2. No person shall operate a Class B commercial motor vehicle
9 unless the person is eighteen (18) years of age or older and holds a
10 valid Class B commercial license, except as provided in paragraph 5
11 of subsection F of this section. Any person holding a valid Class B
12 commercial license shall be permitted to operate motor vehicles in
13 Classes B, C and D, except as provided for in paragraph 4 of this
14 subsection.

15 3. No person shall operate a Class C commercial motor vehicle
16 unless the person is eighteen (18) years of age or older and holds a
17 valid Class C commercial license, except as provided in subsection F
18 of this section. Any person holding a valid Class C commercial
19 license shall be permitted to operate motor vehicles in Classes C
20 and D, except as provided for in paragraph 4 of this subsection.

21 4. No person under twenty-one (21) years of age shall be
22 licensed to operate any motor vehicle which is required to be
23 placarded for hazardous materials pursuant to 49 C.F.R., Part 172,
24 subpart F, except as provided in subsection F of this section;

1 provided, a person eighteen (18) years of age or older may be
2 licensed to operate a farm vehicle which is required to be placarded
3 for hazardous materials pursuant to 49 C.F.R., Part 172, subpart F,
4 except as provided in subsection F of this section.

5 5. A person at least seventeen (17) years of age who
6 successfully completes all examinations required by law may be
7 issued by Service Oklahoma:

8 a. a restricted Class A commercial license which shall
9 grant to the licensee the privilege to operate a Class
10 A or Class B commercial motor vehicle for harvest
11 purposes or a Class D motor vehicle, or

12 b. a restricted Class B commercial license which shall
13 grant to the licensee the privilege to operate a Class
14 B commercial motor vehicle for harvest purposes or a
15 Class D motor vehicle.

16 6. No person shall operate a Class D motor vehicle unless the
17 person is sixteen (16) years of age or older and holds a valid Class
18 D license, except as provided for in Section 6-102 or 6-105 of this
19 title. Any person holding a valid Class D license shall be
20 permitted to operate motor vehicles in Class D only.

21 C. Any person issued a driver license pursuant to this section
22 may exercise the privilege thereby granted upon all streets and
23 highways in this state.

1 D. No person shall operate a motorcycle or motor-driven cycle
2 without having a valid Class A, B, C or D license with a motorcycle
3 endorsement. Except as otherwise provided by law, any new applicant
4 for an original driver license shall be required to successfully
5 complete a written examination, vision examination, and driving
6 examination for a motorcycle as prescribed by the Department of
7 Public Safety, in conjunction with Service Oklahoma, and a certified
8 state-approved motorcycle basic rider course approved by the
9 Department, in conjunction with Service Oklahoma, if the applicant
10 is seventeen (17) years of age or younger to be eligible for a
11 motorcycle endorsement ~~thereon~~ on such license. The written
12 examination and driving examination for a motorcycle shall be waived
13 by Service Oklahoma upon verification that the person has
14 successfully completed a certified Motorcycle Safety Foundation
15 rider course approved by the Department, in conjunction with Service
16 Oklahoma.

17 E. Except as otherwise provided by law, any person who lawfully
18 possesses a valid Oklahoma driver license which is eligible for
19 renewal shall be required to successfully complete a written
20 examination, vision examination and driving examination for a
21 motorcycle as prescribed by the Department, in conjunction with
22 Service Oklahoma, and a certified state-approved motorcycle basic
23 rider course approved by the Department, in conjunction with Service
24 Oklahoma, if the person is seventeen (17) years of age or younger to

1 be eligible for a motorcycle endorsement. The written examination
2 and driving examination for a motorcycle shall be waived by Service
3 Oklahoma upon verification that the person has successfully
4 completed a certified Motorcycle Safety Foundation rider course
5 approved by the Department, in conjunction with Service Oklahoma.

6 F. 1. Any person eighteen (18) years of age or older may apply
7 for a restricted Class A, B or C commercial learner permit. Service
8 Oklahoma, after the applicant has passed all parts of the
9 examination for a Class D license and has successfully passed all
10 parts of the examination for a Class A, B or C commercial license
11 other than the driving examination, may issue to the applicant a
12 commercial learner permit which shall entitle the person having
13 immediate lawful possession of the commercial learner permit and a
14 valid Oklahoma driver license or provisional driver license pursuant
15 to Section 6-212 of this title to operate a Class A, B or C
16 commercial motor vehicle upon the public highways solely for the
17 purpose of behind-the-wheel training in accordance with rules
18 promulgated by the Department.

19 2. This commercial learner permit shall be issued for a period
20 as provided in Section 6-115 of this title of one (1) year;
21 provided, such commercial learner permit may be suspended, revoked,
22 canceled, denied or disqualified at the discretion of the
23 Department, with notice to Service Oklahoma, for violation of the
24 restrictions, for failing to give the required or correct

1 information on the application or for violation of any traffic laws
2 of this state pertaining to the operation of a motor vehicle.

3 Except as otherwise provided, the lawful possessor of a commercial
4 learner permit who has been issued a commercial learner permit for a
5 minimum of fourteen (14) days may have the restriction requiring an
6 accompanying driver removed by satisfactorily completing a driver's
7 examination; provided, the removal of a restriction shall not
8 authorize the operation of a Class A, B or C commercial motor
9 vehicle if such operation is otherwise prohibited by law.

10 3. No person shall apply for and Service Oklahoma shall not
11 issue an original Class A, B or C driver license until the person
12 has been issued a commercial learner permit and held the permit for
13 at least fourteen (14) days. Any person who currently holds a Class
14 B or C license and who wishes to apply for another class of
15 commercial driver license shall be required to apply for a
16 commercial learner permit and to hold the permit for at least
17 fourteen (14) days before applying for the Class A or B license, as
18 applicable. Any person who currently holds a Class A, B or C
19 license and who wishes to add an endorsement or remove a restriction
20 for which a skills examination is required shall be required to
21 apply for a commercial learner permit and to hold the permit for at
22 least fourteen (14) days before applying for the endorsement.

23 4. A commercial learner permit shall be issued by Service
24 Oklahoma as a separate and unique document which shall be valid only

1 in conjunction with a valid Oklahoma driver license or provisional
2 driver license pursuant to Section 6-212 of this title, both of
3 which shall be in the possession of the person to whom they have
4 been issued whenever that person is operating a commercial motor
5 vehicle as provided in this subsection.

6 5. After one renewal of a commercial learner permit, as
7 provided in paragraph 2 of this subsection, a commercial permit
8 shall not be renewed again. Any person who has held a commercial
9 learner permit for the initial issuance period and one renewal
10 period shall not be eligible for and Service Oklahoma shall not
11 issue another renewal of the permit; provided, the person may
12 reapply for a new commercial learner permit, as provided for in this
13 subsection.

14 G. 1. For purposes of this title:

15 a. "REAL ID Compliant Driver License" or "Identification
16 Card" means a driver license or identification card
17 issued by this state that has been certified by the
18 United States Department of Homeland Security (USDHS)
19 as compliant with the requirements of the REAL ID Act
20 of 2005, ~~Public Law~~ P.L. No. 109-13. A REAL ID
21 Compliant Driver License or Identification Card and
22 the process through which it is issued incorporate a
23 variety of security measures designed to protect the
24 integrity and trustworthiness of the license or card.

1 A REAL ID Compliant Driver License or Identification
2 Card will be clearly marked on the face indicating
3 that it is a compliant document, and

- 4 b. "REAL ID Noncompliant Driver License" or
5 "Identification Card" means a driver license or
6 identification card issued by this state that has not
7 been certified by the United States Department of
8 Homeland Security (USDHS) as being compliant with the
9 requirements of the REAL ID Act of 2005. A REAL ID
10 Noncompliant Driver License or Identification Card
11 will be clearly marked on the face indicating that it
12 is not compliant with the federal REAL ID Act of 2005
13 and is not acceptable for official federal purposes.
14 The driver license or identification card will have a
15 unique design or color indicator that clearly
16 distinguishes it from a compliant license or card.

17 2. Original Driver License and Identification Card Issuance:

- 18 a. Application for an original REAL ID Compliant or REAL
19 ID Noncompliant Driver License or Identification Card
20 shall be made to Service Oklahoma or a licensed
21 operator provided such licensed operator is authorized
22 to process application for REAL ID Compliant Driver
23 Licenses and Identification Cards. Application for a
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1 REAL ID Noncompliant Driver License or Identification
2 Card shall be made to Service Oklahoma.

3 b. Service Oklahoma employees or authorized licensed
4 operators shall perform all document recognition and
5 other requirements needed for approval of an original
6 REAL ID Compliant Driver License or Identification
7 Card application. Service Oklahoma employees shall
8 perform all document recognition and other
9 requirements needed for approval of a REAL ID
10 Noncompliant Driver License or Identification Card
11 application.

12 c. Upon approval of an original REAL ID Compliant or REAL
13 ID Noncompliant Driver License or Identification Card
14 application, the applicant may take the approved
15 application document to a licensed operator to receive
16 a temporary driver license or identification card.

17 d. The licensed operator shall process the approved REAL
18 ID Compliant or REAL ID Noncompliant Driver License or
19 Identification Card application and upon payment shall
20 provide the applicant a temporary driver license or
21 identification card. A temporary driver license or
22 identification card shall afford the holder the
23 privileges otherwise granted by the specific class of
24 driver license or identification card for the period

1 of time listed on the temporary driver license or
2 identification card or the period of time prior to the
3 applicant receiving a REAL ID Compliant or REAL ID
4 Noncompliant Driver License or Identification Card,
5 whichever time period is shorter.

6 3. REAL ID Compliant Driver License and Identification Card

7 Renewal and Replacement:

- 8 a. Application for renewal or replacement of a REAL ID
9 Compliant Driver License or Identification Card may be
10 made to Service Oklahoma or to a licensed operator~~7~~1
11 provided~~7~~ such licensed operator is authorized to
12 process application for REAL ID Compliant Driver
13 Licenses and Identification Cards. A licensed
14 operator may process the voluntary downgrade of a REAL
15 ID Compliant Commercial Driver License to any lower
16 class license upon request of the licensee~~7~~1 provided~~7~~
17 no additional endorsements or restrictions are placed
18 on the license.
- 19 b. Service Oklahoma employees or authorized licensed
20 operators shall perform all document recognition and
21 other requirements needed for approval of a renewal or
22 replacement REAL ID Compliant Driver License or
23 Identification Card application.

1 c. Upon approval of a renewal or replacement REAL ID
2 Compliant Driver License or Identification Card
3 application, the applicant may receive a temporary
4 driver license or identification card from Service
5 Oklahoma or an authorized licensed operator.

6 d. A temporary driver license or identification card
7 acquired under the provisions of this paragraph shall
8 afford the holder the privileges otherwise granted by
9 the specific class of driver license or identification
10 card being renewed or replaced for the period of time
11 listed on the temporary driver license or
12 identification card or the period of time prior to the
13 applicant receiving a REAL ID Compliant Driver License
14 or Identification Card, whichever time period is
15 shorter.

16 e. For purposes of this title, an application for a REAL
17 ID Compliant Driver License or Identification Card by
18 an individual with a valid Oklahoma-issued driver
19 license or identification card shall be considered a
20 renewal of a REAL ID Compliant Driver License or
21 Identification Card.

22 4. REAL ID Noncompliant Driver License and Identification Card

23 Renewal and Replacement:
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- 1 a. Application for renewal or replacement of a REAL ID
2 Noncompliant Driver License or Identification Card may
3 be made to Service Oklahoma or to a licensed operator.
4 A licensed operator may process the voluntary
5 downgrade of a REAL ID Noncompliant Commercial Driver
6 License to any lower class license upon request of the
7 licensee~~+~~, provided~~+~~ no additional endorsements or
8 restrictions are added to the license.
- 9 b. Service Oklahoma employees or licensed operators shall
10 perform all document recognition and other
11 requirements needed for approval of a renewal or
12 replacement REAL ID Noncompliant Driver License or
13 Identification Card application.
- 14 c. Upon approval of a renewal or replacement REAL ID
15 Noncompliant Driver License or Identification Card
16 application, the applicant may receive a temporary
17 driver license or identification card from Service
18 Oklahoma or a licensed operator.
- 19 d. A temporary driver license or identification card
20 acquired under the provisions of this paragraph shall
21 afford the holder the privileges otherwise granted by
22 the specific class of driver license or identification
23 card being renewed or replaced for the period of time
24 listed on the temporary driver license or

1 identification card or the period of time prior to the
2 applicant receiving a REAL ID Noncompliant Driver
3 License or Identification Card, whichever time period
4 is shorter.

5 H. 1. The fee charged for an approved application for an
6 original Oklahoma REAL ID Compliant or REAL ID Noncompliant Driver
7 License or an approved application for the addition of an
8 endorsement to a current valid Oklahoma REAL ID Compliant or REAL ID
9 Noncompliant Driver License shall be assessed in accordance with the
10 following schedule:

22 2. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 1104 of this
23 title, all monies collected from the fees charged for Class A, B and
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1 C commercial licenses pursuant to the provisions of this subsection
2 shall be deposited in the General Revenue Fund of this state.

3 I. The fee charged for any failed examination shall be Four
4 Dollars (\$4.00) for any license classification. Notwithstanding the
5 provisions of Section 1104 of this title, all monies collected from
6 such examination fees pursuant to the provisions of this subsection
7 shall be deposited in the General Revenue Fund of this state.

8 J. In addition to any fee charged pursuant to the provisions of
9 subsection H of this section, the fee charged for the issuance or
10 renewal of a REAL ID Noncompliant Driver License shall be in
11 accordance with the following schedule; provided, that any applicant
12 who has a CDL Learner Permit shall be charged only the replacement
13 fee for the issuance of the license:

1 K. In addition to any fee charged pursuant to the provisions of
 2 subsection H of this section, the fee charged for the issuance or
 3 renewal of a REAL ID Compliant Driver License shall be in accordance
 4 with the following schedule; provided, that any applicant who has a
 5 CDL Learner Permit shall be charged only the replacement fee for the
 6 issuance of the license:

22 L. A commercial learner permit may be renewed one time for a
 23 period of one hundred eighty (180) days. The cost for the renewed
 24 permit shall be the same as for the original permit.

1 M. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 1104 of this
2 title, of each fee charged pursuant to the provisions of subsections
3 J, K, and L of this section:

4 1. Five Dollars and fifty cents (\$5.50) of a 4-year license or
5 Eleven Dollars (\$11.00) of an 8-year license shall be deposited to
6 the Trauma Care Assistance Revolving Fund created in Section 1-
7 2530.9 of Title 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

8 2. Six Dollars and seventy-five cents (\$6.75) of a 4-year
9 license or Thirteen Dollars and fifty cents (\$13.50) of an 8-year
10 license shall be deposited to the Department of Public Safety
11 Computer Imaging System Revolving Fund to be used solely for the
12 purpose of administration and maintenance of the computerized
13 imaging system of the Department through October 31, 2022.

14 Beginning November 1, 2022, Six Dollars and seventy-five cents
15 (\$6.75) of a 4-year license or Thirteen Dollars and fifty cents
16 (\$13.50) of an 8-year license shall be deposited to the Service
17 Oklahoma Computer Imaging System Revolving Fund to be used solely
18 for the purpose of administration and maintenance of the
19 computerized imaging system of Service Oklahoma;

20 3. Ten Dollars (\$10.00) of a 4-year license or Twenty Dollars
21 (\$20.00) of an 8-year license shall be deposited to the Department
22 of Public Safety Revolving Fund for all original or renewal
23 issuances of licenses through October 31, 2022. Beginning November
24 1, 2022, Ten Dollars (\$10.00) of a 4-year license or Twenty Dollars

1 (\$20.00) of an 8-year license shall be deposited to the Service
2 Oklahoma Revolving Fund for all original or renewal issuances of
3 licenses; and

4 4. Five Dollars (\$5.00) of a 4-year license or Six Dollars
5 (\$6.00) of an 8-year license shall be deposited to the State Public
6 Safety Fund created in Section 2-147 of this title.

7 N. All original and renewal driver licenses shall expire as
8 provided in Section 6-115 of this title.

9 O. 1. Through May 31, 2025, any person sixty-two (62) to
10 sixty-four (64) years of age during the calendar year of issuance or
11 renewal of a Class D license or motorcycle endorsement shall be
12 charged the following prorated fee:

17 2. Any person sixty-five (65) years of age or older during the
18 calendar year of issuance or renewal of a Class D license or
19 motorcycle endorsement shall not be charged a fee.

20 P. No person who is currently in active service with or has
21 been honorably discharged from active service in any branch of the
22 Armed Forces of the United States or Oklahoma National Guard and who
23 has been certified by the United States Department of Veterans
24 Affairs, its successor or the Armed Forces of the United States to

1 ~~be a disabled veteran in receipt of compensation at the one hundred~~
2 ~~percent rate for a permanent disability sustained through military~~
3 ~~action or accident resulting from disease contracted while in such~~
4 ~~active service and is registered with the veterans registry created~~
5 by the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs shall be charged a
6 fee for the issuance, replacement or renewal of an Oklahoma driver
7 license; provided, that if a veteran has been previously exempt from
8 a fee pursuant to this subsection, no registration with the veterans
9 registry shall be required.

10 Q. In accordance with the provisions of subsection G of this
11 section, Service Oklahoma is authorized to promulgate rules for the
12 issuance and renewal of driver licenses authorized pursuant to the
13 provisions of Sections 6-101 through 6-309 of this title; provided,
14 that no such rules applicable to the issuance or renewal of REAL ID
15 Noncompliant Driver Licenses shall create more stringent standards
16 than such rules applicable as of January 1, 2017, unless directly
17 related to a specific change in statutory law concerning standards
18 for REAL ID Noncompliant Driver Licenses. Applications, upon forms
19 approved by Service Oklahoma, for such licenses shall be handled, in
20 accordance with the provisions of subsection G of this section, by
21 the licensed operator; provided, Service Oklahoma is authorized to
22 assume these duties in any county of this state. Each licensed
23 operator accepting applications for driver licenses shall receive
24 Six Dollars (\$6.00) for a 4-year REAL ID Noncompliant Driver License

1 or Twelve Dollars (\$12.00) for an 8-year REAL ID Noncompliant Driver
2 License or Ten Dollars (\$10.00) for a 4-year REAL ID Compliant
3 Driver License or Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for an 8-year REAL ID
4 Compliant Driver License to be deducted from the total collected for
5 each license or renewal application accepted through June 30, 2023.
6 Beginning July 1, 2022, and ending on June 30, 2023, each motor
7 license agent or licensed operator accepting applications for driver
8 licenses for individuals over the age of sixty-five (65) years or
9 for applications for drivers pursuant to subsection P of this
10 section shall receive Six Dollars (\$6.00) for a 4-year driver
11 license or Twelve Dollars (\$12.00) for an 8-year driver license to
12 be deducted daily by the motor license agent or licensed operator
13 receipts. Beginning July 1, 2023, these fees shall be retained by
14 the licensed operator pursuant to subsection E of Section 1141.1 of
15 this title. The fees received by the licensed operator, authorized
16 by this subsection, shall be used for operating expenses. The
17 amount retained pursuant to this subsection shall not be retained by
18 any state agency. The fees received by the licensed operator,
19 authorized by this subsection, shall be used for operating expenses.
20 For purposes of this subsection, "licensed operator" shall mean an
21 individual who obtains a license from the Service Oklahoma Operator
22 Board to operate a designated Service Oklahoma location and offers
23 third-party fulfillment of designated services to be rendered by
24 Service Oklahoma.

1 R. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 1104 of this title
2 and subsection Q of this section and except as provided in
3 subsections H and M of this section, the first Sixty Thousand
4 Dollars (\$60,000.00) of all monies collected pursuant to this
5 section shall be paid by the Oklahoma Tax Commission to the State
6 Treasurer to be deposited in the General Revenue Fund of the State
7 Treasury.

8 The next Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00) of monies
9 collected pursuant to this section shall be paid by the Tax
10 Commission to the State Treasurer to be deposited each fiscal year
11 under the provisions of this section to the credit of the Department
12 of Public Safety Restricted Revolving Fund for the purpose of the
13 Oklahoma Law Enforcement Telecommunications System. All other
14 monies collected in excess of Five Hundred Sixty Thousand Dollars
15 (\$560,000.00) each fiscal year shall be apportioned as provided in
16 Section 1104 of this title, except as otherwise provided in this
17 section.

18 S. Service Oklahoma shall retain the images displayed on
19 licenses and identification cards issued pursuant to the provisions
20 of Sections 6-101 through 6-309 of this title which may be used
21 only:

22 1. By a law enforcement agency for purposes of criminal
23 investigations, missing person investigations or any law enforcement
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1 purpose which is deemed necessary by the Commissioner of Public
2 Safety;

3 2. By the driver licensing agency of another state for its
4 official purpose; and

5 3. As provided in Section 2-110 of this title.

6 All agencies approved by the Oklahoma Law Enforcement
7 Telecommunications System (OLETS) or the National Law Enforcement
8 Telecommunications System (NLETS) to receive photographs or
9 computerized images may obtain them through OLETS or through NLETS.
10 Photographs or computerized images may be obtained by law
11 enforcement one inquiry at a time.

12 The computer system and related equipment acquired for this
13 purpose must conform to industry standards for interoperability and
14 open architecture. The Department of Public Safety may promulgate

16 T. No person may hold more than one state-issued or territory-
17 issued driver license or identification card from Oklahoma or any
18 other state or territory. Service Oklahoma shall not issue a driver
19 license to a person who has been previously issued a driver license
20 or identification card until such license or identification card has
21 been surrendered to Service Oklahoma by the applicant. Provided,
22 any person who holds both a driver license and identification card
23 from Oklahoma as of November 1, 2025, may continue to possess both
24 credentials until the first expiration of either credential. At

1 that time, the person shall be allowed to retain, replace, or renew
2 either the driver license or identification card and shall surrender
3 the second credential to Service Oklahoma. Service Oklahoma may
4 promulgate rules related to the issuance of replacement REAL ID
5 Compliant Driver Licenses in the event of loss or theft.

6 U. Beginning May 24, 2021, and ending on June 30, 2023, in
7 addition to the amounts provided in subsection Q of this section, a
8 licensed operator shall receive Five Dollars (\$5.00) for each
9 processed application for a REAL ID Compliant 4-year Driver License
10 and Ten Dollars (\$10.00) for each processed application for a REAL
11 ID Compliant 8-year Driver License. Any additional amounts provided
12 pursuant to this subsection shall not be retained by Service
13 Oklahoma.

14 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2026.

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
