SENATE BILL 649

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to driver licenses; allowing for the designation of durable medical equipment donor on certain licenses; requiring promulgation of rules by Service Oklahoma; defining term; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6-126 of Title 47, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. Upon application for issuance or renewal of a driver license or identification card, the applicant may elect to donate durable medical equipment upon death to a non-profit entity selected by Service Oklahoma. Service Oklahoma shall promulgate rules to allow for the inclusion of a mark or symbol that identifies the individual as a durable medical equipment donor and to determine the location on the credential where such information shall be placed.

B. As used in this section, "durable medical equipment" means equipment including, but not limited to, hearing aids, eyeglasses, walkers, canes, and wheelchairs.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
