**Research Analysis**

The Senate Amendments to HB 1086 restore the title and enacting clause.

The measure requires gifts, grants, or donations that a school put in its general fund to be included in the carryover calculation. The measure also restores the penalty issued to school districts that have carryover balances above the allowable amount, beginning with the 2025 fiscal year. Lastly, the measure removes a calculation used to determine the weighted membership for students using online instruction from districts where they are not a resident.
