Research Analysis

The Senate Amendments to HB 1096 removes statutory references to the American College Testing Program (ACT) and replaces it with language expanding testing options to other college entrance exams including the ACT, SAT and Classical Literacy Test (CLT). This change allows a student's score on the CLT to qualify them for the Oklahoma State Regents Academic Scholars Program. The change also allows a student's score on the SAT or CLT to qualify them for Oklahoma's Promise. Currently only a student's score on the ACT can qualify them for these scholarships. Any student taking the CLT must take it in a brick-and-mortar testing center, as defined in the measure.
