**Research Analysis**

The policy committee recommendation for HB 1375 requires the Corporation Commission to hire a consulting firm to study the feasibility of nuclear energy generation in this state. The measure lists the requirements of the study and authorizes the Commission to pay the consultant up to \$375,000.

**Fiscal Analysis**

The policy recommendation to HB 1375 requires the Corporation Commission to contract with an outside consulting firm regarding a nuclear energy feasibility study. The measure sets an expenditure limit of Three Hundred Seventy-Five Thousand Dollars (\$375,000) for the Corporation Commission to conduct the study. Therefore, the fiscal impact of this measure has a maximum amount of \$375,000 to state appropriations.
