Research Analysis

The conference committee report to HB 1486 removes the Mayor Jeff Shockley Memorial Highway designation and adds a new designation for the Ambassador Neal McCaleb Memorial Interchange in Oklahoma County. Additionally, the title is restored to the measure.

Fiscal Analysis

This measure designates 24 new memorial road and/or bridge signs and amends two currently in statute. According to the Oklahoma Department of Transportation (ODOT), the cost per sign is about \$925.00, and as each designation has 2 markers, one for each side of the roadway, that is about \$1850.00 for each designation. With the 26 different markers in this measure that is a total of \$48,100.00 for all of them. As ODOT is an appropriated agency, this does create a potential fiscal impact to the state budget of \$48,100.00.

This \$48,100 is the most that ODOT may have to spend, as policy requires that ODOT only pay for the full cost of the signs for those who were killed in the line of duty as a military member, law enforcement officer, firefighter, or other first responder. Given this information, it is likely that the final impact will be less than the \$48,100.

The Floor Amendment adds two more places for designated signs. That increases the impact by \$3,700.00 for a total possible impact of \$51,800.00.

The Amendment to the Floor Amendment does not change the fiscal impact of the measure.

The CCR does not change the fiscal impact of the measure.
