### **Research Analysis**

The proposed policy committee substitute to HB 1676 removes the end date of the Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner (SANE) Statewide Coordinator position under the direction of the District Attorney Council. The measure also establishes that the SANE Statewide Coordinator is to receive an annual salary between \$125,000 and \$140,000 paid for from funds appropriated to the District Attorneys Council.

### **Fiscal Analysis**

HB 1676 in its current form requires the employ by the District Attorneys Council (DAC) of a Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner (SANE), at a salary between \$125,000-140,000. This additional cost for DAC is estimated to be \$168,188; calculated as follows:

Salary: (\$120,000);  
FICA:  $(125,000 * 7.65\% = \$9,563)$ ;  
OPERS:  $(125,000 * 16.5\% = \$20,626)$ ; and  
FBA:  $(1,500/\text{month} * 12 \text{ months} = \$18,000)$ .
