## **Research Analysis**

CCR A to HB 1683 adopts the Senate Amendments and restores the title on the bill.

The Senate Amendments to HB 1683 provides that a six-month supply of the contraceptive drug will be obtained each subsequent time that the enrollee obtains the same drug and that an enrollee must only obtain one six-month supply in a six-month period.

HB 1683 provides that any health benefit plan offered, issued, or renewed on or after the effective date that covers contraceptives must provide coverage for an enrollee to obtain a three-month supply of a contraceptive the first time and then a six-month supply at once each subsequent time. An enrollee may only obtain a six-month supply once every six months. Nothing in the measure prohibits an individual from obtaining a smaller supply of contraceptives as well as nothing in the measure requires coverage for a contraceptive not intended for regular or routine use.
