**Research Analysis**

CCR C to HB 1683 provides that insurers or prepaid vision plans will not impact the pricing of noncovered services or materials, provides that insurers or prepaid vision plan must provide standard reimbursements for all lenses with the same design, quality, and composition, outlines that an insurer or a prepaid vision plan must not use extrapolation to complete a vision care provider audit, and that an insurer or a prepaid vision must not incentivize patients to receive vision care at a facility owned by the insurer or the plan and if receiving care at a facility owned wholly or partially by the insurer or plan, notice must be provided.
