Research Analysis

The senate amendment to HB 1865 removes section one, which related to felony convictions in tribal courts and renumbers subsequent sections accordingly.

HB 1865, as amended, updates Oklahoma's election procedures by incorporating provisions related to emergency ballot printing and election day voting locations. The measure allows the Secretary of the State Election Board to approve additional ballot printing on election day in cases of shortages or emergencies while maintaining existing provisions for accessible ballots. Additionally, the measure establishes that vote centers, where voters can cast ballots regardless of precinct, will not be used on election day, except in emergencies affecting specific precincts, as determined by the Secretary.
