Fiscal Analysis

The committee substitute to HB 1907 outlines a battery stewardship plan to be followed by certain battery manufacturers and to be administered by the Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ). The measure provides for an annual fee, to be paid by battery producers, that is set by DEQ. According to DEQ, the agency projects the need to add one full-time equivalent (FTE) at an estimated recurring cost for salary and benefits of One Hundred Thousand Six Hundred and Three Dollars (\$100,603.00) to fulfill the requirements of this measure. However, the fee charged would offset the cost of the additional FTE and DEQ would not require additional appropriations. Therefore, this measure would result in a net zero impact to state budgetary resources.
