The second amendment to HB 2189 moves the commission's expiration date to November 1, 2028, removes the membership term limits, and requires an additional comprehensive annual report to be submitted to the Legislature.

**Fiscal Analysis**

This measure creates the Oklahoma Workforce Housing Commission and requires the Oklahoma Housing Finance Agency (OHFA) to take several actions. OHFA is still reviewing the measure, but believes there will be some cost to the agency under this measure. As OHFA is a non-appropriated state agency, there should be no fiscal impact to the state budget from this measure.

This amendment does not change the fiscal impact of the measure.
