**Fiscal Analysis**

The FULLPCS1 to HB2710 creates the Oklahoma Emergency Communications, and sets forth various mandates for the Office of Management and Enterprise Services related to funding, transferring funds to, or directly supporting the program. OMES expects this impact to be minimal, and will use existing budgetary resources within the agency if needed. Therefore, there is no material impact on state budget or appropriations.

The FULLPCS1-AMD1 deletes language that previously set forth a statutory guideline for a certain salary range. This provides more discretion to the agency in hiring, and does not change the fiscal impact of the measure.
