**Research Analysis**

The Floor substitute to HB 2713 requires the Corporation Commission, Department of Public Safety, county sheriffs, and all other duly authorized peace officers to seize and take into custody any vehicle whose annual registration has been expired for six months or more.

Changes made in the Floor Substitute:

Increased the time period at which law enforcement can seize a vehicle for failure to register from 90 days to 6 months. Changed "may seize" to "shall seize". Removed section relating to penalty assessment.
