Research Analysis

The conference committee substitute for HB 2752 requires any utility company seeking to use eminent domain for the construction of a 300kV transmission line to first obtain a Certificate of Authority from the Corporation Commission. The measure also clarifies that utilities using natural gas have the power of eminent domain. The measure also prohibits the use of eminent domain for siting renewable energy facilities on private property.

Lastly, the measure clarifies that it does not require any Oklahoma retail electric supplier or rural electric cooperative to secure a Certificate of Authority for any extension, rebuild, or upgrade to an electric transmission facility.
