## **Research Analysis**

The Senate amendment to HB 2752 remove the phrase "as required in Enrolled House Bill No. 2756 of the 1st Session of the 60th Oklahoma Legislature."

The amendment does not have a substantive effect on the bill. The measure, as amended, requires any company seeking to use eminent domain for the construction of a 300kV transmission line to first obtain a Certificate of Authority from the Corporation Commission. The measure also clarifies that utilities using natural gas have the power of eminent domain. Lastly, the measure prohibits the use of eminent domain for siting renewable energy facilities on private property.

## **Fiscal Analysis**

The Senate amendment to HB 2752 requires any entity seeking to exercise eminent domain for certain electric transmission facilities to obtain a Certificate of Authority from the Corporation Commission. Upon review, this measure has no direct fiscal or revenue considerations for the state.
