**Research Analysis**

The polpcs2 for HB 2807 amends the definition of *owner* to specify it only means persons and entities listed. The polpcs2 also removes that an employee conducts any other additional business for the benefit of the a medical marijuana commercial license holder. The measure excludes drinks in the products sold to dispensaries only in pre-packaged forms and weights.

**Fiscal Analysis**

HB 2807 clarifies statutory language regarding the permitting process for each warehouse location operated by a commercial transporter. The measure also closes a loophole in current statute by requiring all stored medical marijuana product be documented in the seed-to-sale system.

The Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority (OMMA) intends to utilize exiting resources to carry out the provisions of the measure. Therefore, HB 2807 is not anticipated to have a direct fiscal impact on the state budget or appropriations.
