Research Analysis

HB 2804 prohibits any person property owner, tenant, employer, or business entity from establishing or enforcing any policy or rule that prohibits any person or employee, except a convicted felon, from transporting, carrying, or storing firearms or ammunition in a locked motor vehicle on any property set aside for any motor vehicle. The measure prohibits any person, property owner, tenant, employer, liquor store, holder of an event permit, place of worship or business entity from establishing any policy or rule that prohibits a person from transporting, carrying, or storing firearms or ammunition in a motor vehicle owned, leased, or rented by the person or employee while conducting business for the business entity. The measure allows a person to bring a civil action to enforce this provision.
