Research Analysis

The proposed policy committee substitute for HB 2950 prohibits state colleges and career tech schools from requiring differentiated admission standards from students based on their educational background. The measure also removes the requirement for homeschooled students, and students from unaccredited schools to have achieved a minimum of 22 on the ACT, SAT, or CLT to be eligible for the Oklahoma's Promise Scholarship. Lastly, the measure extends the deadline to apply for OHLAP to the age of 18 for all students.
