HB 2999 as introduced, prohibits the requirement for public officials to sign nondisclosure agreements based on the performance of their duties in relation to a project that would affect utility infrastructure for at least 10 percent of the residents of the project area. The provisions of this measure are not applicable to nondisclosure agreements related to personal matters or litigation.
