**Research Analysis**

The proposed oversight committee substitute to HB 3056 excludes sales of raw, unpasteurized cow milk, goat milk, or sheep milk from the Oklahoma Milk and Milk Products Act. This measure permits producers to advertise the sale of unpasteurized milk, limits where such products are sold, and requires such products to meet labeling criteria.

**Fiscal Analysis**

The proposed committee substitute to HB 3056 excludes unpasteurized cow milk, goat milk, and sheep milk from the provisions of the Oklahoma Milk and Milk Products Act. The measure adds locations at which these types of milk can be sold directly to consumers as well as removes a section establishing a threshold for incidental sales of goat milk. Upon review, this measure has no direct fiscal or revenue considerations for the state.
