Research Analysis

HB 3056 as introduced excludes the sales of unpasteurized cow, goat, sheep, donkey, and horse milks to consumers at feed stores, restaurants, farmer's markets, or via delivery from the farm where the milk is produced from the Oklahoma Milk and Milk Products Act. Strikes language that limited the monthly incidental sales of goat milk to 100 gallons.
