Research Analysis

The proposed oversight committee substitute for HB3075 establishes rounding rules for cash payments made to state governmental entities and political subdivisions. Payments will be rounded to the nearest nickel as follows:

- \$0.01–\$0.02 → \$0.00
- \$0.03–\$0.04 → \$0.05
- \$0.06–\$0.07 → \$0.05
- \$0.08–\$0.09 → \$0.10

State agencies must adopt the rounding rule immediately whereas political subdivisions have until July 1, 2027 to comply, unless directed earlier by Congress.

To make up for any rounding difference, discrepancies in property tax collections will be absorbed by the county's unappropriated general fund revenue. For all other payments, political subdivisions may handle rounding differences using any fund under their control.
