Research Analysis

HB 3076, as introduced, allows teachers to receive certification through alternative teacher preparation programs, including programs provided by public schools, regional service agencies, and private or not-for-profit entities. The Commission must issue a request for information from potential program providers, and provide them with application information. The Commission must approve or deny applications within 60 days, and must provide denied applicants the opportunity to remedy any deficiencies.

The Commission is further required to promote these alternative preparation programs to potential teachers, and the State Board of Education must post a list of approved providers on their website.

Lastly, the measure transfers oversight of alternative teacher certification programs from the State Board of Education to the Commission for Educational Quality and Accountability.
