Research Analysis

HB 3126, as introduced, requires the Commissioners of the Land Office to annually transfer money from the permanent school fund to the State Regents for Higher Education to fund concurrent enrollment. The amount of money the Regents can request from the fund will be based on its financial performance.

Fiscal Analysis

The measure in it's current form would alter the funding methodology for the concurrent enrollment program within the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education. Currently, the program is funded by an appropriation from the Legislature after being provided a dollar figure by the Regents in their budget request.

This measure would create a revolving fund within the CLO where revenue that is generated by the CLO's corpus would be directed for the purposes of funding the concurrent enrollment program. As such, the total annual disbursement to Oklahoma's colleges and university's would be reduced by that amount. For reference, the total appropriated amount to the Regents for concurrent enrollment was \$20,492,168.
