Research Analysis

The proposed policy committee substitute to HB 3145 clarifies that hunting tags shall be provided by the Oklahoma Wildlife Conservation Commission. This measure also eliminates tag fees for feral swine and exotic wildlife not native to North America which are hunted for sport and killed in a commercial hunting area.

Fiscal Analysis

The second proposed policy committee substitute to HB 3145 adds feral swine and exotic wildlife not native to North America as except from requiring a tag when they are hunted for sport and killed at commercial hunting area. Any loss in revenue would impact the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation, a non-appropriated state agency. Therefore, this measure has no fiscal or revenue considerations on FY-27 state budgetary resources.
