**Research Analysis**

The proposed policy committee substitute for HB 3194 adds that a pregnancy center or medical pregnancy center may refer a woman who requests contraceptives to a different clinic or hospital.

HB 3194 provides that the state or any other entity within can do the following:

- Require a pregnancy center or medical pregnancy center to offer or perform abortions;
- Require a pregnancy center or medical pregnancy center to offer, provide, or distribute abortion-inducing drugs or contraception;
- Require these centers to refer for abortion, abortion-inducing drugs, or contraception;
- Require these centers to counsel in favor of abortion, abortion-inducing drugs, or contraception;
- Require these centers to post anything that promotes or provides information on obtaining an abortion, abortion-inducing drugs, or contraception;
- Prohibit a center from providing services because they do not perform, refer, or counsel in favor of abortion, abortion-inducing drugs, or contraception;
- Prohibit a center from providing pre- and post-natal resources because they do not perform, refer, or counsel in favor of abortion, abortion-inducing drugs, or contraception;
- Prohibit a medical pregnancy center from providing medical testing, counseling and care because it doesn't perform, refer, or counsel in favor of abortion, abortion-inducing drugs, or contraception;
- Prohibit a medical pregnancy center from providing counseling on any pregnancy-related medical care or treatment;
- Interfere with the pregnancy center's staffing or hiring decisions.

A pregnancy center, medical pregnancy center, or any party aggrieved by a violation of this act may commence a civil action. The measure allows the Legislature to appoint one or more of its members to intervene in any case in which the constitutionality or enforceability of the act is challenged.
