**Research Analysis**

The second proposed policy committee substitute for HB 3239 requires a veterinarian using telehealth to have established the veterinarian-client-patient relationship through an in-person exam within the last 12 months, rather than solely through electronic means.

The measure also modifies the definition of veterinarian-client-patient relationship and adds new definitions for medical records, relief veterinarian, and heard health plan in the Oklahoma Veterinary Practice Act.
