Research Analysis

HB 3306 as introduced, establishes that a candidate committee must file a Statement of Organization with the Ethics Commission no later than 10 days after the candidate expends any funds. Previously the candidate did not have to file unless they expended more than \$1,000.

Fiscal Analysis

House Bill 3306 amends campaign finance statutes by changing the contribution threshold that triggers the requirement to file a Statement of Organization. The bill does not authorize new expenditures or appropriations, and any associated administrative costs are expected to be absorbed within existing budgetary resources. Therefore, the measure is not anticipated to have a direct fiscal impact on the state budget or appropriations.
