HB3341, as introduced, repeals the small business guaranty fee tax credit. The credit allows certain financial institutions, whose main office is located in the state, to claim a credit against the guaranty fees that the institution pays to the Small Business Administration.

Fiscal Analysis

In its current form, HB3341 repeals the small business guaranty fee tax credit. As this tax credit is regularly claimed, repealing the credit is expected to increase revenue. The magnitude of the increase is difficult to estimate due to significant variance in historical utilization.
