**Research Analysis**

HB 3502, as introduced, provides that no person will be denied the opportunity to become an adoptive parent and the placement of a child will not be denied or delayed on the basis of refusal, unwillingness, or lack of support to enable the child to engage in a gender transition. The measure also provides that raising a juvenile consistent with their biological sex does not constitute child abuse or neglect or child endangerment.
